I am requesting \$4,000,000 for the GE Pump Station and Force Main Improvement project in Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26). The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Mebane, located at 106 E Washington Street, Mebane, NC 27302. The funding would be used to increase the existing pump station capacity which has encountered a 40% reduction in pumping capacity. Investing in this infrastructure could strengthen the local economy and create high-paying opportunities to benefit rural communities.
