I am requesting \$2,500,000 for the Carver Creek Supportive Housing Rehabilitation—Phase II project in Fiscal Year 2027 (FY27). The entity to receive funding for this project is Durham County, located at 200 E. Main St., Durham, NC 27701. The funding would be used to complete the next phase of rehabilitation of Carver Creek Apartments.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help prevent housing displacement in Durham while preserving the existing affordable housing supply and improving housing accessibility for disabled individuals in particular.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(4).
